The deadline for submission is 31 August 2017

The Workshop will consider any aspects or issues related to the theoretical and empirical analysis, the design or the implementation of antitrust policy (collusion, vertical and horizontal restraints, abuse of dominance, mergers) and sectoral regulation (infrastructure and public services, including energy, telecoms, transport, water and sanitation).

The accepted contributions are expected to be relevant for understanding the most challenging problems of competition and regulation of Latin America and Caribbean countries. This allows for papers addressing issues in other regions when those issues are deemed relevant to the Latin American context. Studies of specific Latin American countries, as well as comparative institutional analyses are also welcome. There will be a dedicated discussant for each paper, as well as open floor discussion.

RIDGE workshops aim to favor the spread of high quality research in economics by bringing together top local and regional researchers working on the frontier of knowledge and policymakers.

Paper Submission

Full papers, written in English, must be submitted for consideration for the meeting. The cover page should include: the title of the paper, institutional affiliation, address, phone and email of each author and an abstract with the appropriate JEL classification.

Each author can submit and present at most one paper.
