The cover page should include: the title of the paper, institutional affiliation, including address, and email of each author and an abstract with the appropriate JEL classification. Priority will be given to papers that are relevant for understanding the most challenging problems of Latin America and Caribbean (LAC) countries including papers that address issues in other regions that are relevant to LAC.
